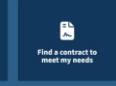

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Who can use the Procurement Co-Pilot?

Federal employees and contractors with a .gov email.

### What data does the Procurement Co-Pilot use?

The Co-Pilot platform leverages government-wide data from the Federal Procurement Data Systems (FPDS) and SAM.gov, along with prices paid data from Best-in-Class (BIC) contract vehicles and the GSA Transactional Data Reporting (TDR) program. Agency-specific pricing data will be included in future iterations.

### How can acquisition professionals use the Procurement Co-Pilot to support market research?

**Research product pricing.** Gain access to prices paid data to improve cost estimates and strengthen negotiation approach, answering the following questions:

- What is a realistic cost estimate for products of interest?
- How does that vary across vendors and contract vehicles?
- When is the best time to buy an item based on historical trends?
- What contract vehicles would be best suited for the products of interest?

**Search for vendors.** Explore a potential vendor landscape across all categories and sizes that could meet procurement needs, answering the following questions:

- How many vendors are available to support a set aside solicitation?
- What vendors are available in defined locations with desired capabilities?
- What services has the vendor provided to the government in the past?

**Find a contract to meet my needs.** Identify cross-agency and agency-specific contract vehicles that may meet procurement needs, answering the following questions:

- What contract vehicles are available to transition an expiring contract?
- What contract vehicles exist with vendor diversity to support effective competition or a set aside?
